Information on the rules

1. DEADLINE

- Deadline to submit your entry: by the end of April 2021
- Notification to all, including finalists: by the end of May 2021
- Presentation of First, Second, Third place winners: June 2021

2. WHO CAN PARTICIPATE

- The competition is for people of the 3rd and 4th Year

3. THEME

- Submit a painting related to Wordsworth’s poem “***I Wandered Lonely as a Cloud***”. The theme of the poem can be broadly interpreted. Students can paint about any aspect that subtly or overtly relates to the poem or any part of it. The entry must show evidence of thoughtful creativity and interpretation and must represent the independent effort of the student

4. PAINTING REQUIREMENTS

- The entry must show evidence of thoughtful research, creativity and interpretation
- There is a limit of 1 item of artwork per student
- Each painting must have the artist's **name, grade, school name** labelled and **properly placed on the back of the entry**.
- You have to use **A3** size panel
- You can use : oil, acrylic, watercolor, pen and ink, pencil, colored pencil, crayon, marker, oil pastels.
- Alongside their work, participants are also required to present a brief overview of the technique employed and of the poem message through a PowerPoint presentation of a maximum length of 4 slides.

5. JUDGEMENT CRITERIA

A panel of judges - Prof.ssa Ramondino (Art Department), Prof.ssa Siccardi, Prof.ssa Barboni (Language Department) - will evaluate the entry on: imagery, content, colorful artwork, adherence to poem style, originality, creativity, technical and formal accuracy and overall presentation

•Entries will be disqualified for any of the following reasons: plagiarism, non adherence to guidelines as stated.

- All entries must be original works without aid from others.
